MHA's invitation for Participation as Cyber Volunteers

Citizens are invited to register themselves as volunteers in the below noted categories in the area related to Cyber Crime:-

- (a) <u>Cyber Volunteer Unlawful Content Flagger:</u> For identifying online illegal/unlawful content like Child Pornography, Rape/Gang Rape, terrorism, radicalisation, anti-national activities etc and reporting to Government.
- (b) <u>Cyber Awareness Promoter</u>: For creating awareness about cybercrime among citizens including vulnerable groups like women, children and elderly, rural population etc.
- (c) <u>Cyber Expert:</u> For dealing with specific domains of cyber crime forensics, network forensics, malware analysis, memory analysis, cryptography etc.

The registration procedure for the volunteers is as follows:

- An individual shall be required to register as volunteer through a dedicated section "Cyber Volunteers" on MHA's National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (https://cybercrime.gov.in).
 He/she shall be required to furnish some mandatory personal particulars like full name, father's name, mobile number, email address etc.
- ID proof and address proof will be required to upload at "Upload ID Proof" tab in registration form.
- For registration as "Cyber volunteer unlawful content flagger", no prior verification (KYC) is required.
- For registration as "Cyber Awareness Promoter or Cyber Expert", Prior Verification (KYC) will be carried out by concerned state.
